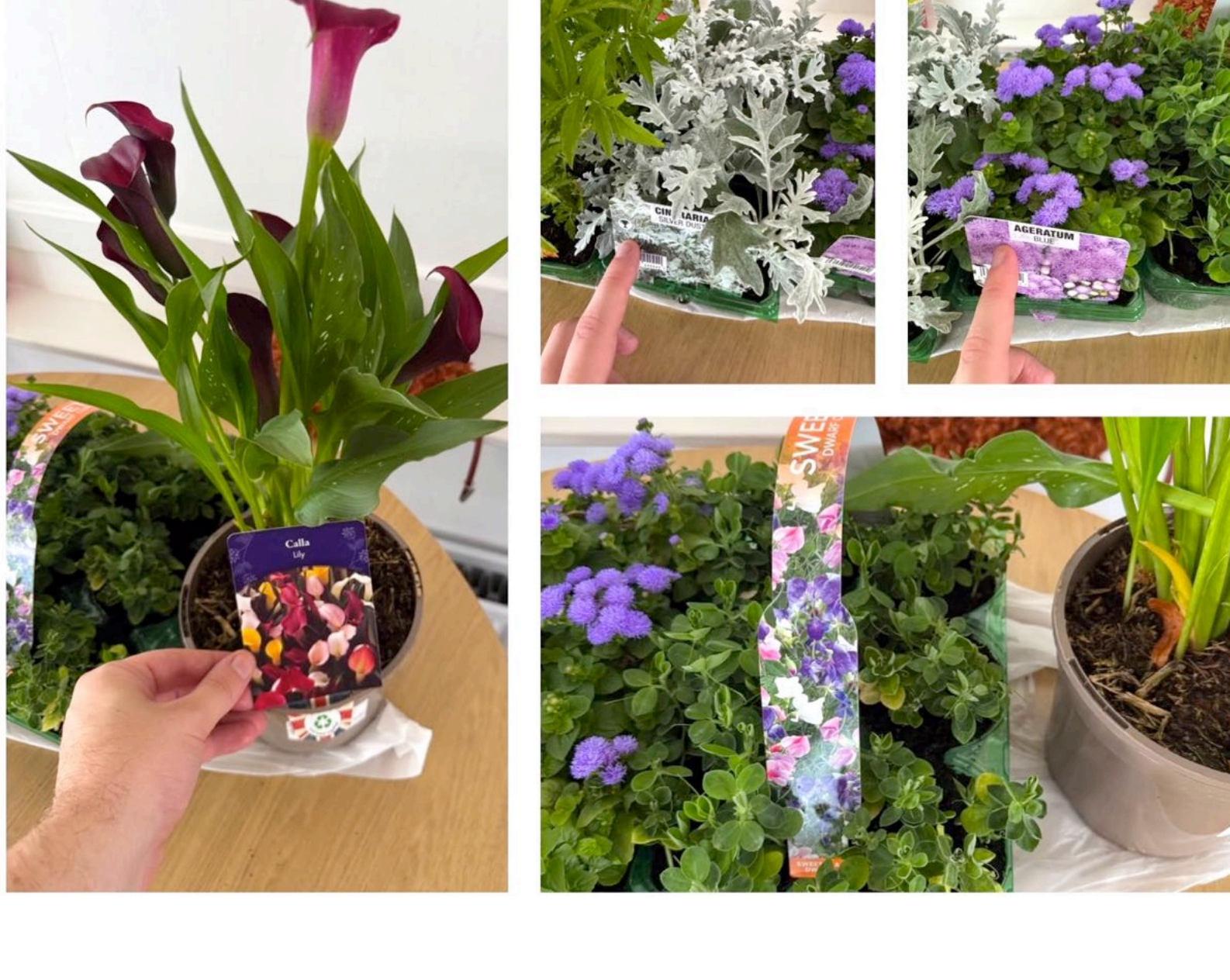
Tea Dance at New Rannoch Day Centre

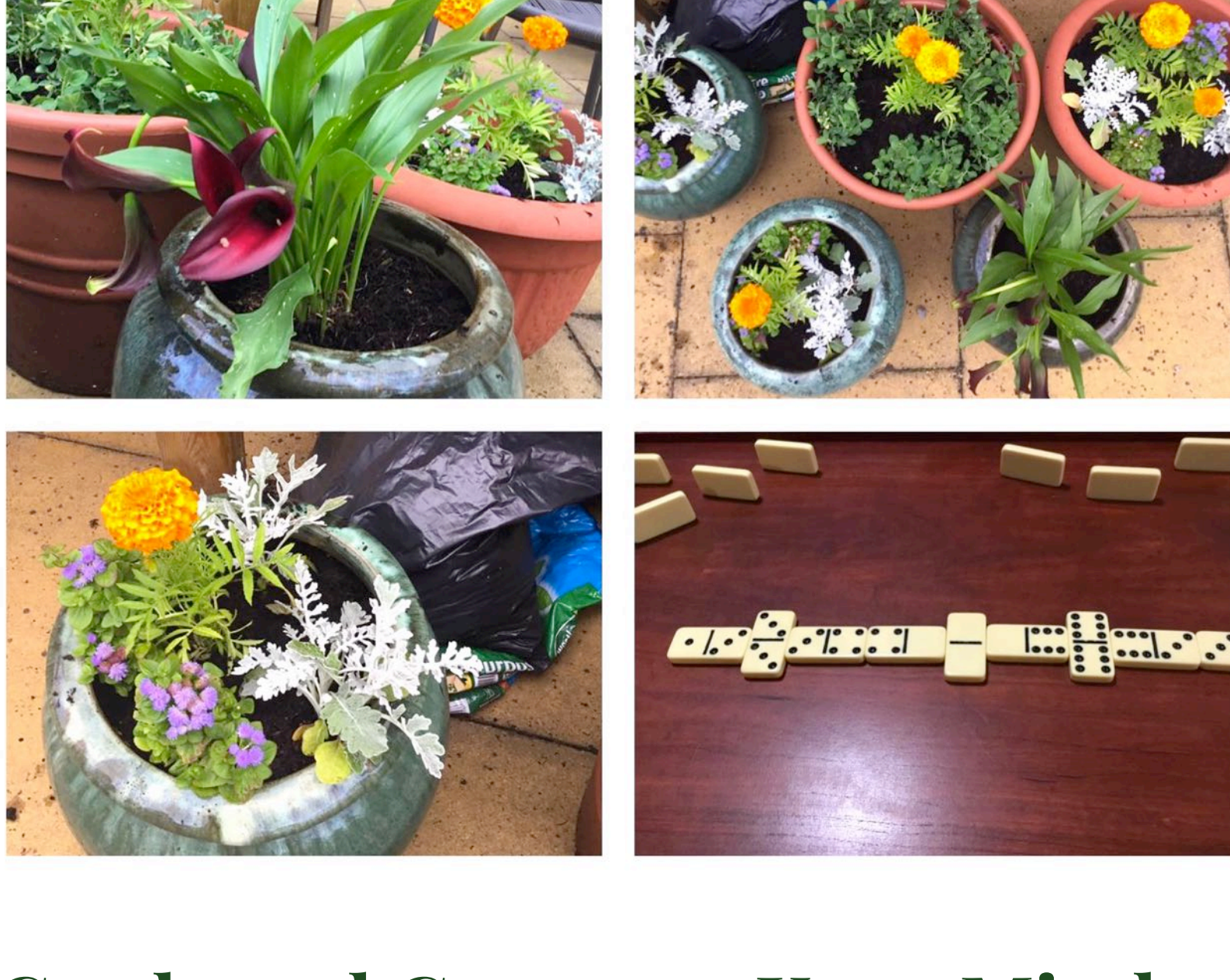
Outing to Dobbies

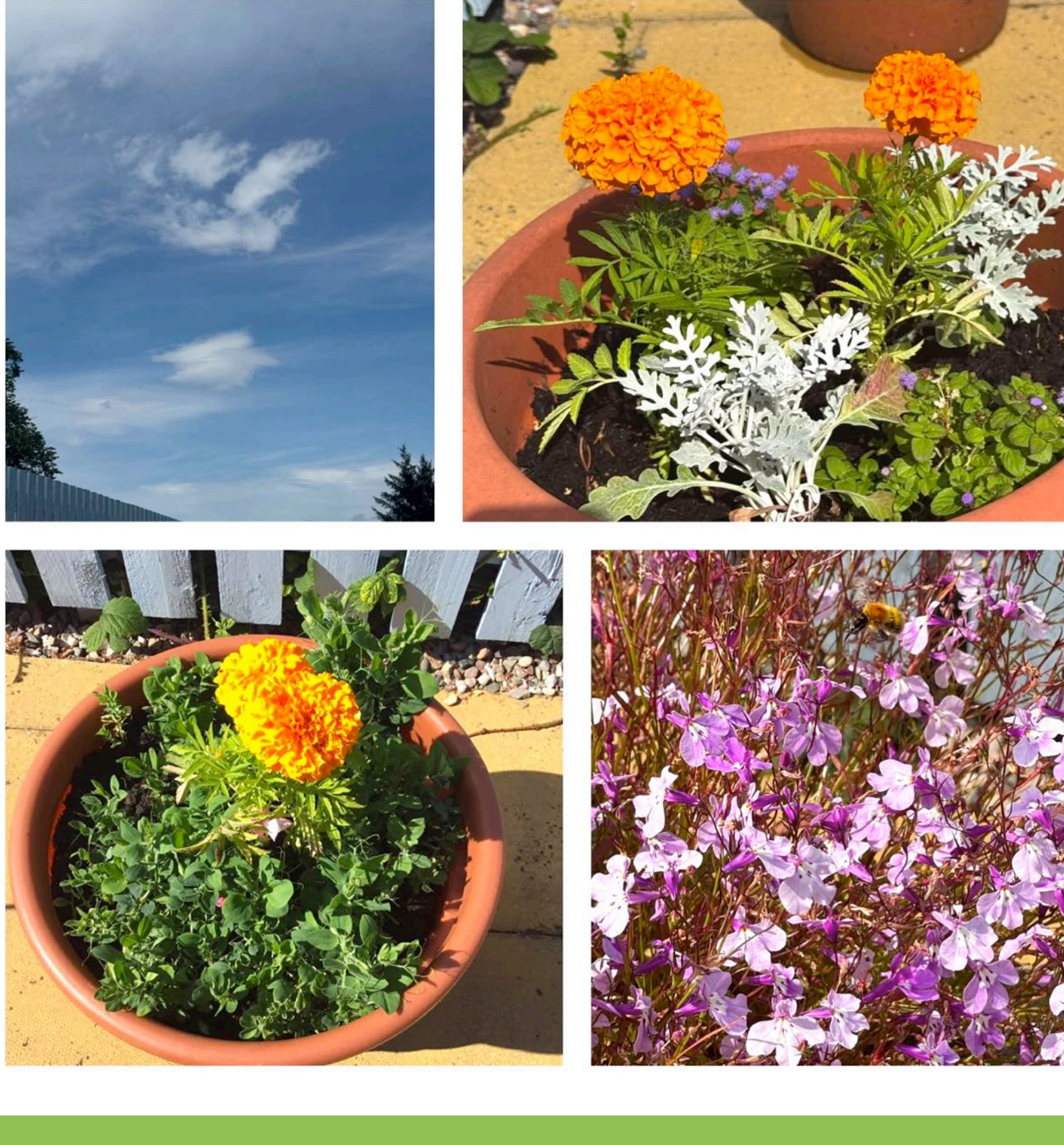
Celebrating 4th July with an Armchair Adventure
